A Work Management System (WMS) hosted by OCWA empowers First Nations communities to effectively and efficiently maintain their water assets.

The WMS will serve as the backbone of your asset maintenance program, providing a dynamic environment for users to store and manage assets, plan and schedule work, and perform reporting and analysis.

Centralizing your maintenance information makes it easily accessible and organized, minimizing the time spent tracking down invoices and work orders. This ensures all maintenance activities are documented, helping to maintain a consistent maintenance schedule and reducing the risk of equipment failures.

What's more, your community benefits from the use of WMS without having to host the system independently. OCWA provides support and training while your community retains control of your assets.

How It Works

- **Asset Tagging:** Physical tags with barcodes are placed on relevant assets, scanned, and uploaded into the system using a mobile app.
- **Data Integration:** Information from the tags is integrated into WMS, creating a comprehensive asset inventory.
- **Preventative Maintenance:** Schedules are created and managed based on the asset inventory.
- **Training and Support:** OCWA provides support throughout the process to ensure smooth implementation and effective use by local operators.

Is the hosted WMS customizable for different communities?

OCWA provides the software and technical support, including setup and training. Once the WMS is implemented, the First Nations community retains full control over its use. Community operators are responsible for entering data, closing work orders, and managing the system daily. Your community retains ownership of its data, with OCWA's enterprise systems ensuring that it is processed and securely stored on our servers.
